Scholarship Application

Qualifications:

2. She must be a female athlete as recognized by her high school or other sources of recommendations.
3. To apply for the scholarship the student must submit the completed application, two letters of recommendation, and the completed essay questions.
4. Show proof of enrollment to an institution of higher education before the scholarship will be awarded.
5. The deadline for submission of application for consideration is May 1, 2012

Application Instruction

1. Student should attach personal Resume
2. Attached to the Resume should be all letters of recommendations and required essays.
3. Student should notify her school counselor and any coaches that have any affiliation. Their names and phone numbers should be included on the resume.
4. Resume should include any additional information about their involvement in any other sports/activities outside of high school.
